# CVO & CEO REPORT

In reflecting on 2022, the successful rebuilding of a strong membership base allowed the Ocean Community YMCA to make great strides in creating opportunities throughout the Branches and the community, always from the perspective **"Where there's a Y, there's a way"**.

Board Members and Senior Staff completed a Strategic Planning Process which will guide us over the next five years, with a focus on four organizational priorities: Uplift Communities, Strengthen Relationships, Build Sustainability through Philanthropy & Fiscal Management and Strengthen our Resources.

Camp enrollment skyrocketed serving record numbers of children, and would have climbed higher, had staff recruitment been easier. Despite this challenge, staff throughout the organization pitched in to assist in creating wonderful memories with kids at Camp Watchaug & Camp Cove.

Community connections were made at each branch this year. New Heights, a day service program for neurodiverse young adults, have actively engaged in Y-Be-Fit at The Naik Family Branch. The Westerly Village, a program for older adults wishing to remain independent, have enrolled in Matter of Balance at the Westerly-Pawcatuck Branch. And, Mentor RI will begin offering group mentoring at the Arcadia Branch.

# HEALTHY LIVING



In partnership with the Livestrong Foundation, the YMCA has developed a cancer survivorship program that assists those who are living with, through, or beyond cancer to regain strength and connect with other cancer survivors.

Our certified trainers receive guidance from The Livestrong Foundation on the best practices for program participants to get back to physical fitness after a cancer diagnosis. These techniques provide an evidenced-based path for adult cancer survivors to return to an active lifestyle. Participants are encouraged, through individualized & group support, to engage in fitness and focus on their overall health.

One participant shares how Livestrong at the YMCA has impacted her: “I am so grateful for this opportunity. It has boosted my energy and confidence. Having an uplifting place to be with accepting and encouraging people outside of my house or a medical office is something I look forward to every week”,

**I am so grateful for this opportunity; It has boosted my energy and confidence!**

“Connecting with others and exercising to mindfully build some strength back raised my physical and mental energy every session. Trying different types of exercise like

water aerobics and dance brought the element of spontaneity and fun back into my life. The leaders connected us to additional support networks nearby. I learned new things about personal care and nutrition with the guest speakers”.

Participants in Livestrong reported that the sense of community was the greatest take-away from the program. Participants have even started, under the leadership of Wellness Director Janine Parkins, a weekly support group at the Westerly-Pawcatuck branch to continue to foster the relationships made during the program.

# YOUTH DEVELOPMENT

---

**I**n partnership with Community Foundation of Eastern Connecticut (CFECT), the YMCA offers families in Norwich our unique summer day camp experience.

Participating Norwich youth (age 5–11) are transported to and from summer camp, to participate in daily swim and boating safety lessons, as well as learn how to navigate in canoes, kayaks and paddle boards.

Additionally, children in the program take part in activities such as archery, arts and crafts, marine science explorations, sports, and low ropes challenges.

One parent writes: “We are all in very difficult situations many with health and financial problems and worse. It was more than enough to have been given this chance for the kids to attend camp. Our community is so thankful. But your camp took this to a new level. The Y was aware of most of our situations on a deep level”.

“Some of our children have been helped a great deal through some traumatic problems and has done so impactfully. The Y made sure to purchase food for our kids to eat every day for breakfast on the bus and snacks for the afternoon. There was more than one time someone could not afford a lunch and parents were told by the kids that the Y got lunch for them”.

# SOCIAL RESPONSIBILITY



**N**ew Heights, a program of Vista Life Innovations, is a program designed for adults with disabilities, providing support throughout various stages of life. With a focus on community integration, New Heights partnered with the Y to implement Y-Be-Fit, a curriculum that seeks to make wellness and nutrition education more accessible and inviting for individuals with disabilities.

Participants exercise by playing wiffle ball, swimming, hiking, and doing yoga. Even life skills such as healthy eating are practiced with staff; encouraging students to participate in hands-on activities like making nutritional snacks and practicing mindfulness.

The Naik Family Branch Health & Wellness Director, Billi-Jean King, has seen evidence of marked improvement in the physical and mental well-being of all participants.

King states: "I have had the privilege of working with students to help build healthy spirit, mind and body through fitness and nutrition. I have been told by many of the participants that they look forward to coming here and learning new exercises, moving to fun music, and discussing healthy meals, snacks, and habits overall".

Leadership from New Heights noted the reason this partnership works so well is directly attributed to the Y Team's responsiveness in meeting the individualized needs of each participant, along with the willingness and ability to improvise as the dynamic needs of participants dictate.

Tailoring specific wellness programs to our neuro-divergent community is our social responsibility. By promoting a healthy lifestyle and offering coaching on best practices, the Ocean Community YMCA helps our community be more inclusive, accepting, and healthier.

# FINANCIAL SUMMARY

The Ocean Community YMCA exceeded budget expectations for 2022. The Change in Net Assets from Operations was a decrease of \$125,000. Total revenues for the year were \$6,944,000, a decrease from 2021 of \$835,000. Contributing factors to the decrease include a decrease in government funds (PPP/ERC) of \$1,549,000. In addition, due to market volatility our investment gains/losses decreased by \$686,000. Program revenue increased by \$214,000 and membership revenue increased by \$1,295,000.
